## REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY IN HUNWICK

**8<sup>th</sup> NOVEMBER 2020**

Under the restrictions, as they are on 19<sup>th</sup> October, a gathering of more than six people at the War Memorial would be illegal. We will be holding the Act of Remembrance in St. Paul's Church as part of the usual Sunday Service starting at 9.00am. The church can legally accommodate 35 people for an act of worship. We have an online seat booking system which will be available from Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> November on the Benefice website – <https://hunwickandwillington.org.uk>

Once all the seats have been reserved, it will not be possible for anyone else to book a seat and we remind people that we cannot allow entry unless an online ticket is presented at the door. The wearing of a face covering is required by law and hand sanitisers will be available at the entrance and within the church.

At the end of the service, we are planning a "march pass" from the church to the War Memorial and without stopping, either back through the cemetery to the church or homeward.

We are also planning a further service and Act of Remembrance in St Paul's Church starting at 10.45am on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> November. The same seat booking system will be employed and we ask that members of the community attend just one of the services allowing the maximum number to attend this year.

## When to self-isolate

Self-isolate immediately if:

- you have any [symptoms of coronavirus](#) (a high temperature, a new, continuous cough or a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste)
- you've tested positive for coronavirus – this means you have coronavirus
- you live with someone who has symptoms or tested positive
- someone in your support bubble has symptoms or tested positive
- [you're told to self-isolate by NHS Test and Trace or the NHS COVID-19 app](#)
- you arrive in the UK from a country with a high coronavirus risk – see [GOV.UK: how to self-isolate when you travel to the UK](#)

## How to self-isolate

You must not leave your home if you're self-isolating.

- do not go to work, school or public places – work from home if you can
- do not go on public transport or use taxis
- do not go out to get food and medicine – order it online or by phone, or ask someone to bring it to your home
- do not have visitors in your home, including friends and family – except for people providing essential care
- do not go out to exercise – exercise at home or in your garden, if you have one.
