Photograph orders **MUST** be returned before Thursday 21st October 2021. Please make sure all other forms are also returned as soon as possible. Thank you.

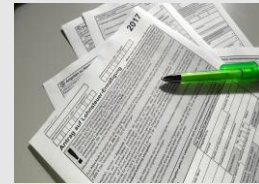


WRAPAROUND AND AFTERSCHOOL CLUBS
