YEAR 6- SECONDARY SCHOOL APPLICATIONS

As you will be aware, your child is due to transfer to secondary school in September next year. **The application process opened on 6 September 2021.**

If you live in County Durham, you need to complete an application to tell Durham County Council which school you want your child to attend. **You should list up to 3 school preferences. Applying for just one school does not improve your chances of gaining a place at that school.** You can apply for any school/academy in County Durham or in another Local Authority area.

Please apply on-line at www.durham.gov.uk/schooladmissions When you apply on-line you will receive an acknowledgement and you will be offered a school place for your child by email on 1 March 2022. **Please save your log-in details** as you will also be able to accept your child's place on-line.
